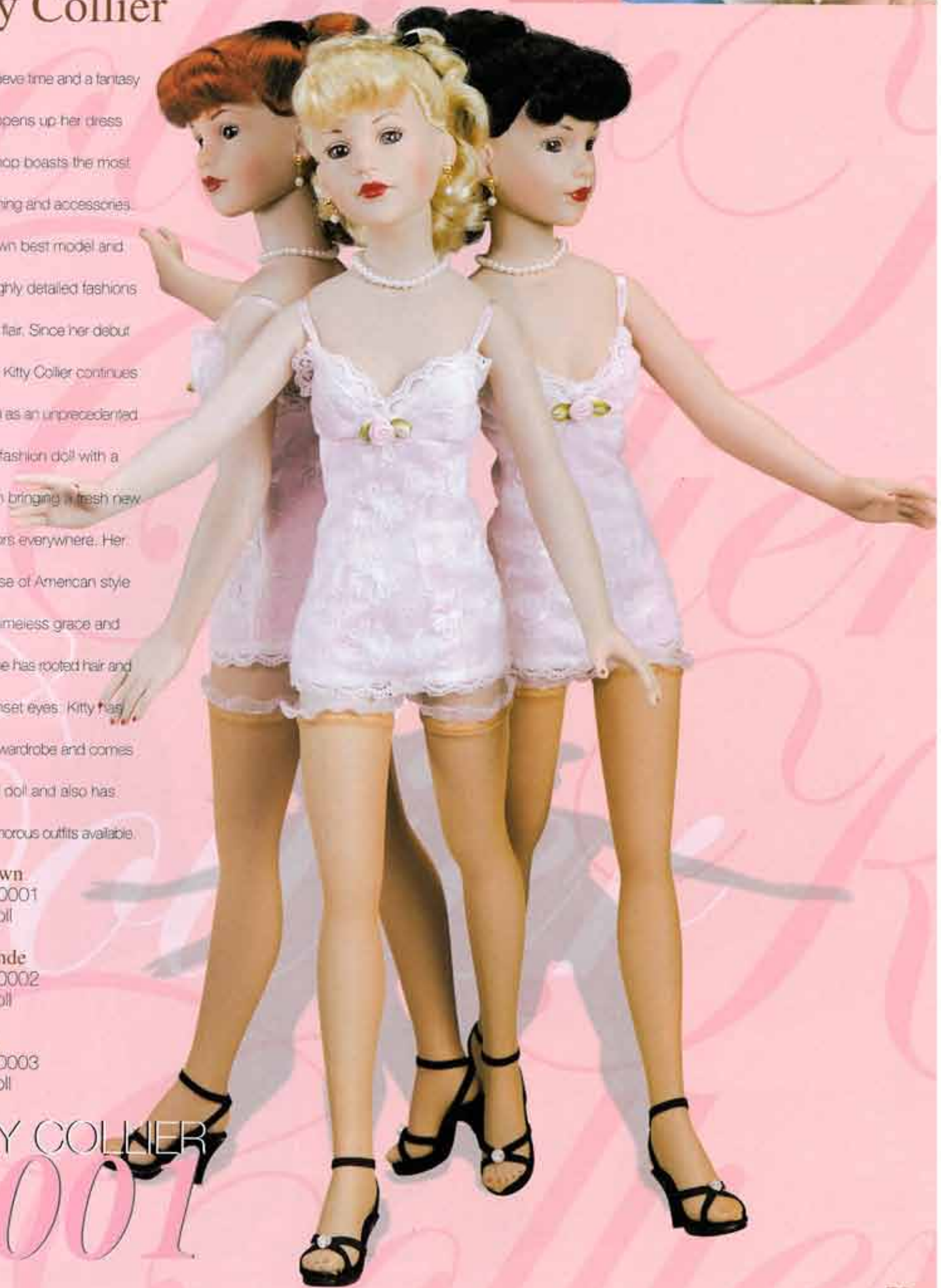

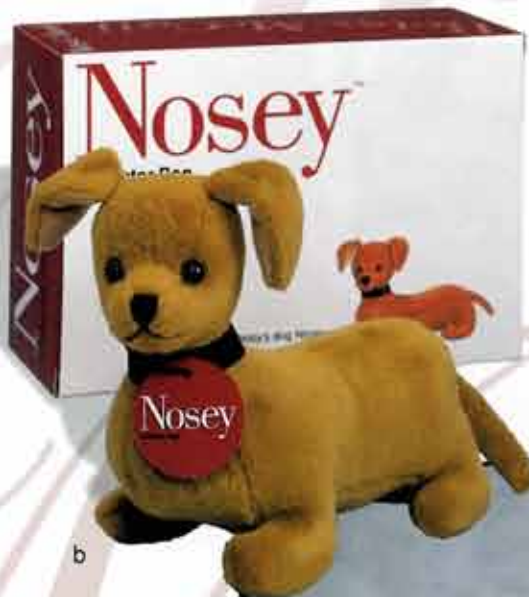

Enter the realm of imagination and fantasy with Clouland playdolls. As a child's companion, or a collector's delight, these are playdolls of the finest quality. Designed for the Tonner Doll Company by renowned cloth doll artist, Shelley Thornton, they reflect her love of fine fabrics and imaginative use of pattern and color. They beckon you to enter a world that is not quite real, but somehow more lovely and comforting. The 24-inch doll is constructed with a fully jointed cloth body, vinyl head, hands and feet, and rooted hair, and is meticulously produced by the Tonner Doll Company.

The Designer: As a dreamy child and a creative adult, Shelley Thornton has always been one with her "head in the clouds." She has brought to the Clouland playdoll project her attention to intriguing details, her unique color palette and her love of patterned and textured fine textiles. It was her goal to design a playdoll with the same serene and dreamy spirit embodied in her sought-after, one-of-a-kind cloth doll creations. She is indebted to Robert Tonner for his unflagging support of her vision, and to her children, eleven year-old Kirby Little Idea Man and patient supporter, and eight year-old Phoebe Little Product Tester and Man Product Advisor.

"Sadly, beautiful objects are few and far between in the current world of mass produced toys," Shelley states. "My intention is to give children the spirit-enhancing experience of owning and treasuring objects with captivating aesthetic value. I know from my own childhood how much a doll can inspire love and imaginative play, and have psychological content. I hope my dolls will be worthy of love."



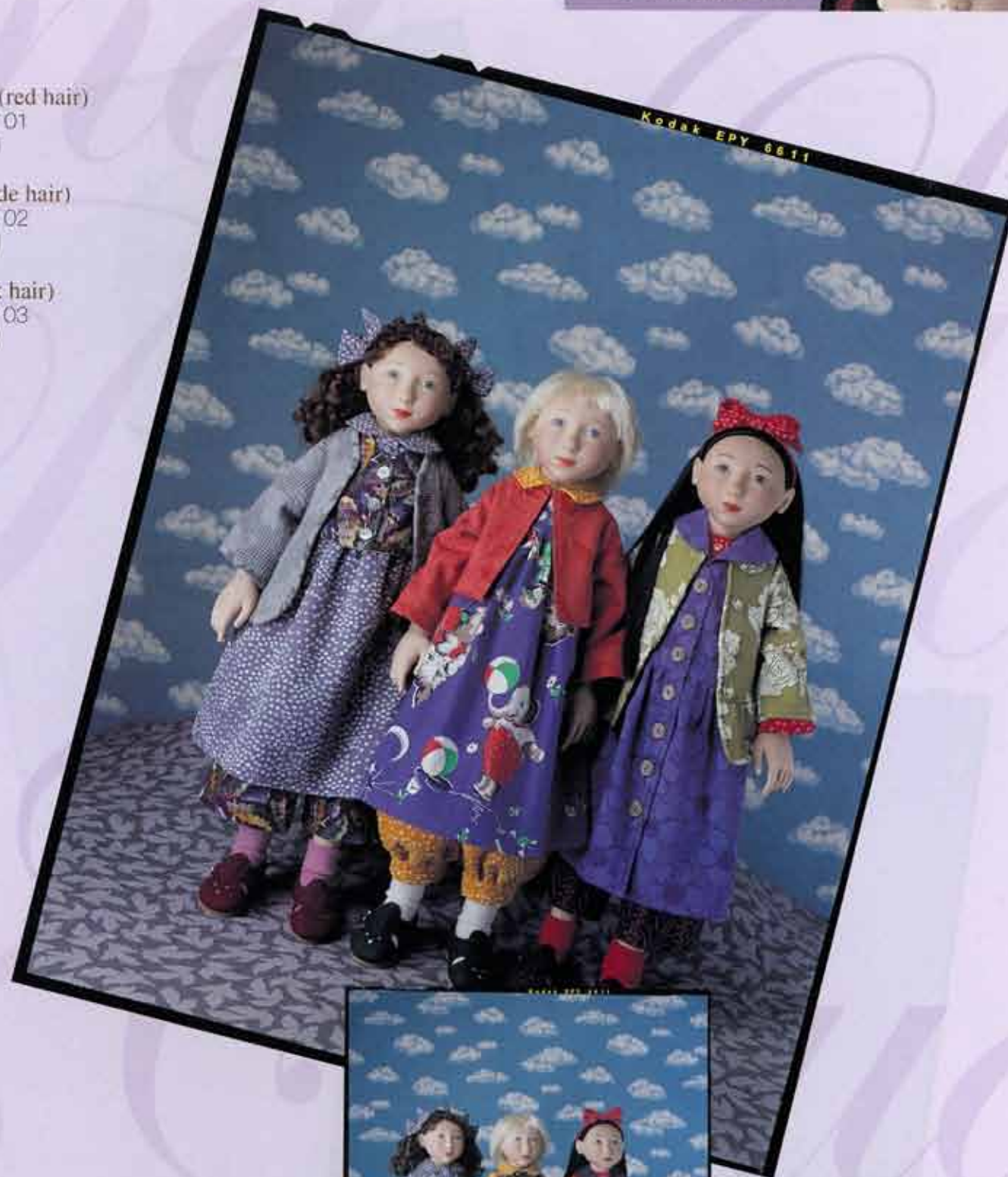

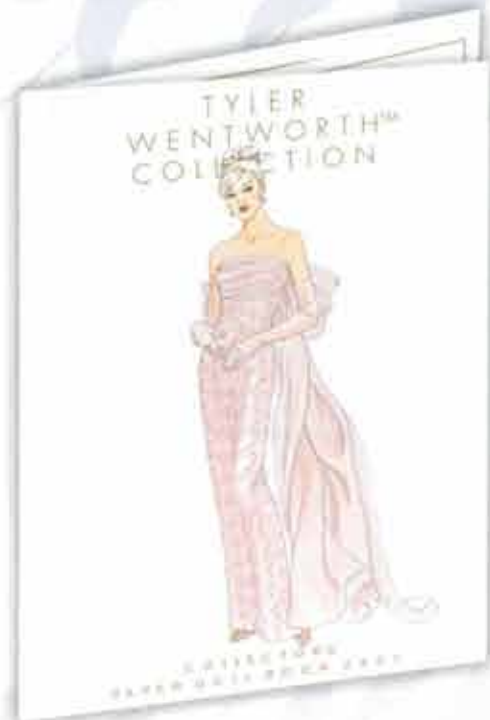

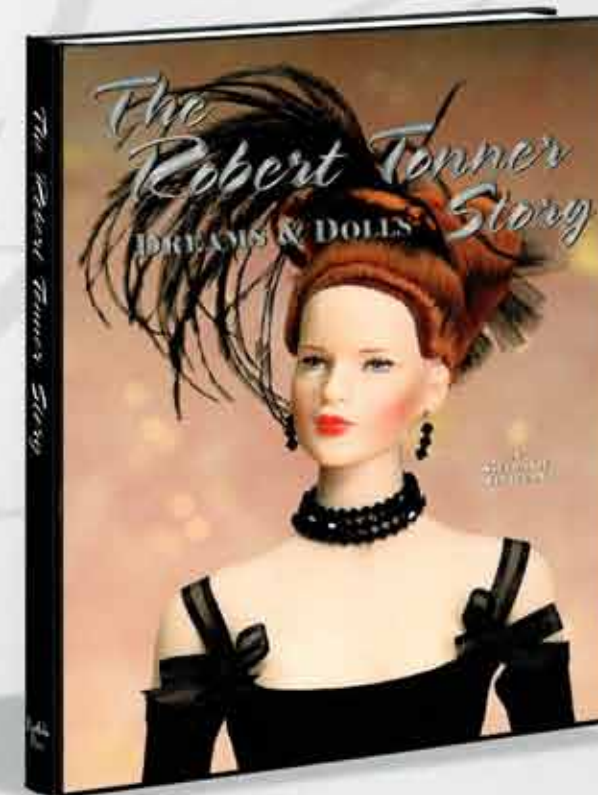
